NOTICE PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SEC. 2254.1036

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 88 ("District"), will consider entering into a contingent fee contract with the law firm of Mitchell, Zientek & Scruggs, LLP ("Firm") and hereby posts this notice pursuant to Sec. 2254.1036 of the Government Code.

WHEREAS, this notice shall be posted before or at the time of giving the written notice required by Government Code Sec. 551.041 for a meeting described by Sec. 2254.1036(2) of the Government Code and shall announce the following:

- A. The District is pursuing a contract with the Firm for services described under GOVT. CODE §1201.027 as bond counsel.
- B. The District believes the Firm has the competency, qualifications, and experience necessary to fulfill this contract.
- C. The nature of any relationship between the District and the Firm is as follows. The Firm currently provides legal services as general counsel and bond counsel to the District.
- D. The District does not currently employ attorneys and/or supporting personnel qualified to provide bond counsel legal services.
- E. Engaging an attorney in private practice who has meaningful experience in public finance matters pursuant to an hourly fee arrangement would likely result in higher fees to be paid by the District, and such fees incurred would be payable by the District, whether or not the securities are issued.
- F. The District believes this contingent fee contract is in its best interest. Fees for legal services in public finance matters, including bond counsel legal services, have traditionally been paid pursuant to a contingent fee arrangement, where such fees become payable only upon the successful issuance of the securities and are payable solely out of the proceeds of the

For each of the reasons stated above, the execution of an engagement agreement with the Firm is in the best interest of the District.
